## COMMERCIAL INSURANCE AND ACCOUNTING TRADE GROUP COUNCIL WAGE RE-OPENER NEGOTIATION

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the Regulations of Commercial Insurance and Accounting Trade Group Council Wage Re-Opener Negotiation

The Commercial, Insurance and Accounting Trade Group Negotiating Council having been meeting to review the Salaries/Wages and Allowances of Employees within the Trade Group concluded discussion and reached agreement on Wednesday 11th May, 2022 at The Board Room of Messrs T. Choithram & Sons Ltd, Rawdon Street, Freetown on the following items.

- (1) THE SALARIES/WAGES CURRENTLY EARNED BY EMPLOYEES BE INCREASED BY TWELVE (12%) PERCENT EFFECTIVE 1ST MAY, 2022.
- (2) THAT SALARIES/WAGES IN SCHEDULE "A3" SALARY SCALES OF THE MAIN AGREEMENT AS AMENDED IN 1ST SEPTEMBER, 2021 BE INCREASED BY TWELVE (12%) PERCENT EFFECTIVE 1ST MAY, 2022.
- (3) THAT THE YEARLY NOTCH TO NOTCH MOVEMENT IN EACH JOB GRADE/SCALE BE FIVE (5%) PERCENT.
- (4) THAT SALARY SCALES DIFFERENTIAL SHALL REMAIN AT EIGHT (8%) PERCENT.
- (5) THAT TRANSPORT ALLOWANCE BE INCREASED BY (LE 130,000) MONTHLY WITH A MINIMUM OF (LE 350,000) EFFECTIVE 1ST MAY, 2022.
- (6) THAT RENT ALLOWANCE BE INCREASED BY (LE 100,000) MONTHLY WITH A MINIMUM OF (LE 350,000) EFFECTIVE 1ST MAY, 2022.
- (7) THAT EMPLOYERS WHO HAVE NOT PAID THE NOTCH MOVEMENT EFFECTIVE JANUARY, 2022 SHALL DO SO BEFORE THE APPLICATION OF THE SALARY INCREASE OF TWELVE (12%) PERCENT DUE 1ST MAY, 2022.
- (8) THAT THE CURRENT TRADE GROUP COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE FOR A PERIOD UP TO DECEMBER, 2023 AND SHALL BE RENEWED THEREAFTER.

### REDENOMINATION OF LEONE - EXTENSION OF THE

### TRANSITION PERIOD

Govt. Notice No. 359

Pursuant to section 18(1) of the Redenomination of the Leone (Consequential Provisions) Regulations, 2022, the Bank of Sierra Leone (hereinafter referred to as the "Bank") hereby states as follows:

- In this Public Notice, reference to the "Old Leone" shall mean the "existing currency"
  as defined in the Redenomination of the Leone (Consequential Provisions)
  Regulations, 2022; and reference to the "New Leone" shall mean the "redenominated currency" as defined in the Redenomination of the Leone (Consequential Provisions)
  Regulations, 2022.
- The transition period of 1st July, 2022 to 30th September, 2022 (wherein both the Old Leone and the New Leone shall be legal tender) is hereby extended to 31st March, 2023.
- Notes and coins denominated in Old Leone shall continue to be legal tender and therefore accepted in transactions in Sierra Leone until 31st March, 2023.
- 4. Effective 1st April, 2023, the Old Leone shall cease to be legal tender.
- The Bank, its designated agents and all commercial banks and other financial institutions shall continue to exchange the Old Leone for the New Leone until 31st March, 2023.
- Between 1st April, 2023 and 15th April, 2023, the Old Leone shall be exchanged for the New Leone at the Bank.
- After 15th April 2023, the Bank shall not exchange the Old Leone for the New Leone.
- 8. This public notice shall become effective on the date it is published in the Gazette.
